The children were also treated to delicious McDonalds Happy Meal – McChicken Burger and a gift pack.





Vinegar is available at the sailing shed.

According to the Cleveland Clinic, seek medical help if you have severe symptoms listed in the graphic.

You can treat mild jellyfish stings using the following steps:

- 1. Wash the tentacles and venom off the affected area of your body with seawater. Don't use fresh water.
- 2. Using tweezers or gloved hands, remove any tentacles you see in your skin.
- 3. Apply vinegar (available at the sailing shed) or rubbing alcohol to the affected area.
- 4. To help reduce the pain, you can put calamine lotion or hydrocortisone cream on a jellyfish sting. You can also use an ice pack or hot water to help with the pain and swelling.
