SHOW & TELL

The Committee conducted a Show and Tell session on 26^{th} November 2023. The Committee assessed the state of our Club sometime in June 2023 after they had been elected, focusing on the critical issues from water leaking to exposed wires to the damage caused by termites' infestation.

Water leaking was spotted in several areas of the Club with unsightly water stains and soggy patches. Water infiltration is evident in several areas of the buildings, affecting both common areas and specific functional spaces.

There are instances of exposed electrical wires in various parts of the club, presenting a serious safety hazard.

These concerns pose significant risks to the safety and well-being of our members and staff. Many members have expressed their dissatisfaction and inconvenience at the state of disrepair of our Club, and they have found it increasingly inconvenient to use the facilities due to malfunctioning equipment, broken furniture, and unsafe conditions. This negatively affects their overall experience of the Club.

On the whole, the disrepair in the Club is a result of both neglect and insufficient maintenance efforts. The routine upkeep and necessary repairs have been neglected for an extended period, leading to the deteriorated state of the Club.

The management has made efforts, and will continue to make efforts, to address the problems. Towards this end, the Committee organized a Show & Tell session with the members on 26 November 2023. Members were given an overview of the remedial projects that have been successfully carried out, an insight into the projects currently in progress, and an outline of pending tasks.

The implementation of preventive measures and routine maintenance will contribute to the long-term safety and sustainability of the Club's facilities. Members' understanding and patience whilst the remedial works are ongoing are greatly appreciated.



Maintenance of Swimming Pool & Snake Temple Structure

The Superstructure beneath the Swimming Pool and Snake Temple were found to have suffered serious erosion requiring significant repairs.

Work commenced on the 22nd Nov 2022 and was completed on the 4th July 2023.













Tree Safety – Phase 1

CUTTING & TRIMMING EXISTING TREES POSING A SAFETY ISSUE

A total of 25 trees between the Club House and Multi Storey building were identified as being potentially dangerous and in need of trimming.

Work commenced on the 23rd November 2023. and was completed on the 30th November 2023.






Snake Temple Improvements

Repairs and improvements were required to the electrical and plumbing system and the Steel structure of the Snake Temple. Additionally a new store room was required to enable the catering operation to proceed.

- The electrical Distribution Board was upgraded to 100 amp with a new Digital Power Meter by the 20th November 2023.
- Corroded elements of the mild steel structure were replaced with Stainless steel units by the 18th November 2023.
- A new store room was completed by the 3rd
 December 23 at a cost of RM7000
- The upgraded plumbing system including a new water Meter was completed by the 3rd December 2023.









Installation of Soundproof wall cladding in the MPH at 14/F

- Work Started on the 10th July 2023 and was completed on the 28th August 2023.
- Defect rectification work was carried out between the 29th November 2023 and 10th December 2023

Multi-Storey Building - 14/Floor – Male Toilets Urinal Flushing System

The automatic sensor flushing system was found to be faulty requiring the urinals to be replaced with a manual press type flush. Improvements to the associated plumbing was also carried out.

Work started on the $22^{\rm nd}$ November $22^{\rm nd}$ and was completed by the $25^{\rm th}$ November 23 .

Water Leak at the 11/F Car Park

- Leaks from the incoming water supply to the Male & Female Toilets at Level 13 & 14 had created an ongoing water leak problem in the 11/F Car Park.
- The ABS pipes serving the Male and Female WC & Basins were replaced with Poly pipes.
- Work started: on the 20th September 2023 and was completed on the 1st October 2023.





During heavy down pours ,rain water was found to overflow from the roof gutter and subsequently leak through the Library wall and ceiling.

The roof top guttering was upgraded with additional outlet points which enabled it to cater for the heaviest downpours resolving the



14/F Kltchen Pipe Blockage

Due to a malfunction of the grease trap a build up of grease blocked the floor drainage of the 14/F Kitchen.

The grease trap was repaired and the drainage pipes replaced with new 4" pipe.


